ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS'

ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR AWARD OF ATTORNEYS' FEES, REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES, AND PAYMENT OF SERVICE AWARDS

This matter came for hearing before the Court on October 5, 2022 and October 21, 2022 on Plaintiffs' motion for an award of attorneys' fees, reimbursement of expenses, and payment of service awards (the "Fee and Expense Application"). The Court, having considered all papers filed and proceedings conducted herein, having found the Settlement reached in this Action with Ford Motor Company of Canada, Ltd. ("Ford Canada") to be fair, reasonable and adequate, and otherwise being fully informed and good cause appearing thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- All capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein have the same meaning as in the Settlement Agreement with Ford Canada.¹
- The Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this application and all matters
 related thereto, including all members of the Class who have not timely and validly
 requested exclusion from the ligation and the Class.
- 3. The Court hereby finds and concludes that due and adequate notice of these proceedings was directed to all persons and entities who are Class Members advising them of the Fee and Expense Application and of their right to object to thereto, and a full and fair opportunity was accorded to persons and entities who are Class Members to be heard with respect to the Fee and Expense Application.
- 4. The Court finds and concludes that notice of the Settlement Agreement was provided to the Class in accordance with the Court's Order Preliminarily Approving Settlement with Ford Canada dated June 23, 2022, including the forms of notice and methods of notifying members of the Class that were approved by the Court. That notice was fair, adequate, and sufficient, constituting the best practicable notice under the circumstances, and was reasonably calculated to reach all or a substantial percentage of the members of the Class and apprise them of this Action, the terms and conditions of

the Settlement Agreement, and their right to opt out and be excluded from the Class and the Settlement Agreement, or to object to the Settlement Agreement. The notice provided fully satisfied all requirements of California Code of Civil Procedure Section 382, California Rules of Court, rules 3.766 and 3.769, all other applicable laws or rules of the Court, and due process.

- 5. Two Settlement Class Members—Timothy R. and Troy S.—filed objections to the Fee and Expense Application. After thoroughly considering these two objections and the briefing and argument submitted by Plaintiffs as to these objections, the Court overrules the objections of Timothy R. and Troy S.
- 6. Plaintiffs' Counsel's Motion is granted, and Plaintiffs' Counsel is hereby awarded from the Settlement Fund:
 - i. Attorneys' fees in the amount of 33.3% of the gross Settlement Fund (\$82 million), or \$27,306,000, plus interest earned thereon for the same time period and at the same rate as that earned on the gross Settlement Fund until the fee is paid; and
 - ii. Litigation expenses in the reduced amount of \$1,293,971.39, which the Court finds to be fair and reasonable.
- 7. The award of attorneys' fees and expenses shall be paid to Plaintiffs' Counsel from the Settlement Fund in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement, which terms, conditions and obligations are incorporated herein.
- 8. Plaintiffs' Counsel's revised request for service awards is granted. Service of awards of \$5,000 each are to be paid to (i) named Plaintiff Jason Gabelsberg; and (ii) named Plaintiff W. Scott Young, for a total service award of \$10,000.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
